

## Children Cope With Divorce 2009 Class Schedule

This is a 4-hour class mandated for parents who are divorcing, separating, or who are involved in custody/other domestic relation legal actions involving their children. Grandparents & Step-parents are welcome. The class advocates for children and it is an educational program and is not meant to serve as counseling, therapy, or ministry. There is a policy that no children are allowed in the class - adults only.
